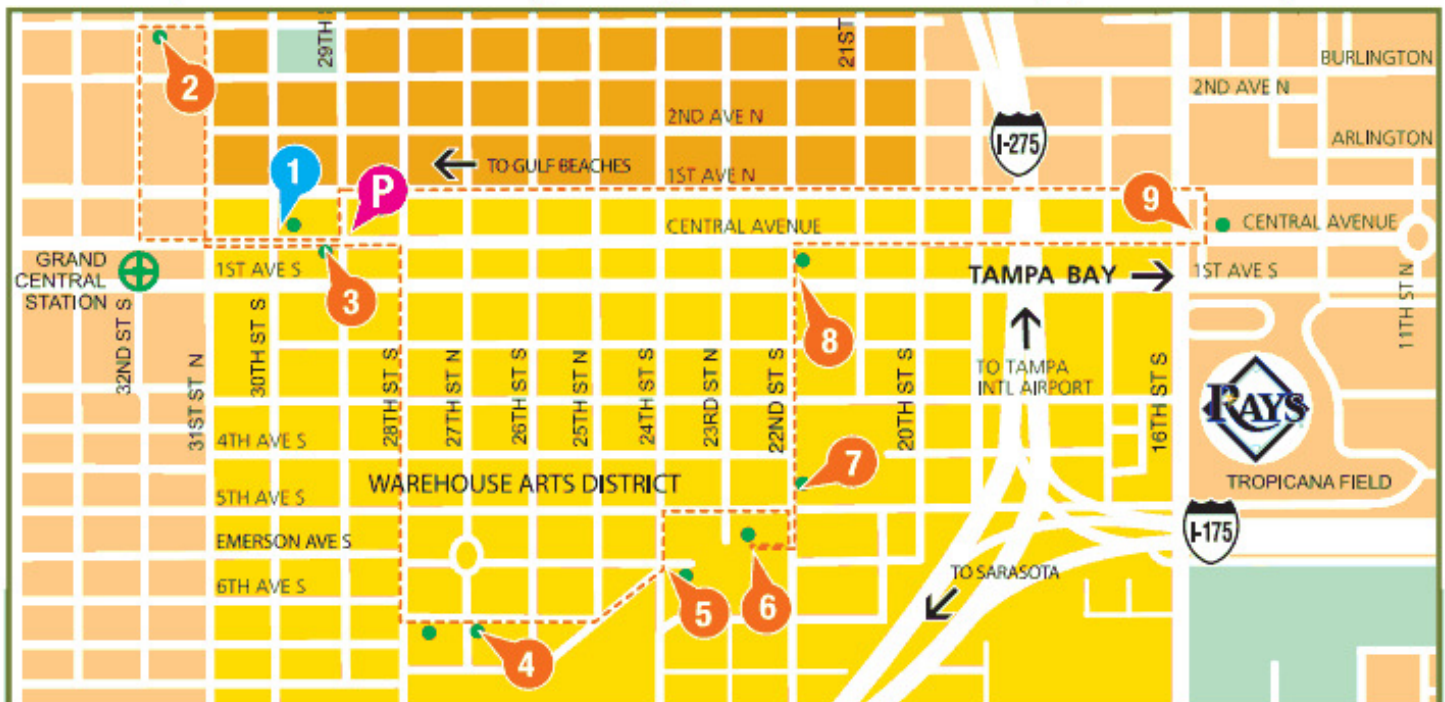


Gallery Walk Trolley Map for Saturday, June 8, 2013
